- EU students have to register their residence in Tallinn and apply for Estonian ID card
- Students from non-EU countries have to apply for long term D-type visa.
- Non-EU students, studying at EU, have to hold the EU visa or residence permit, what is issued for studies
- Students who have visa free entrance, if possible, please apply for visa before your arrival to Estonia



LIVING EXPENSES

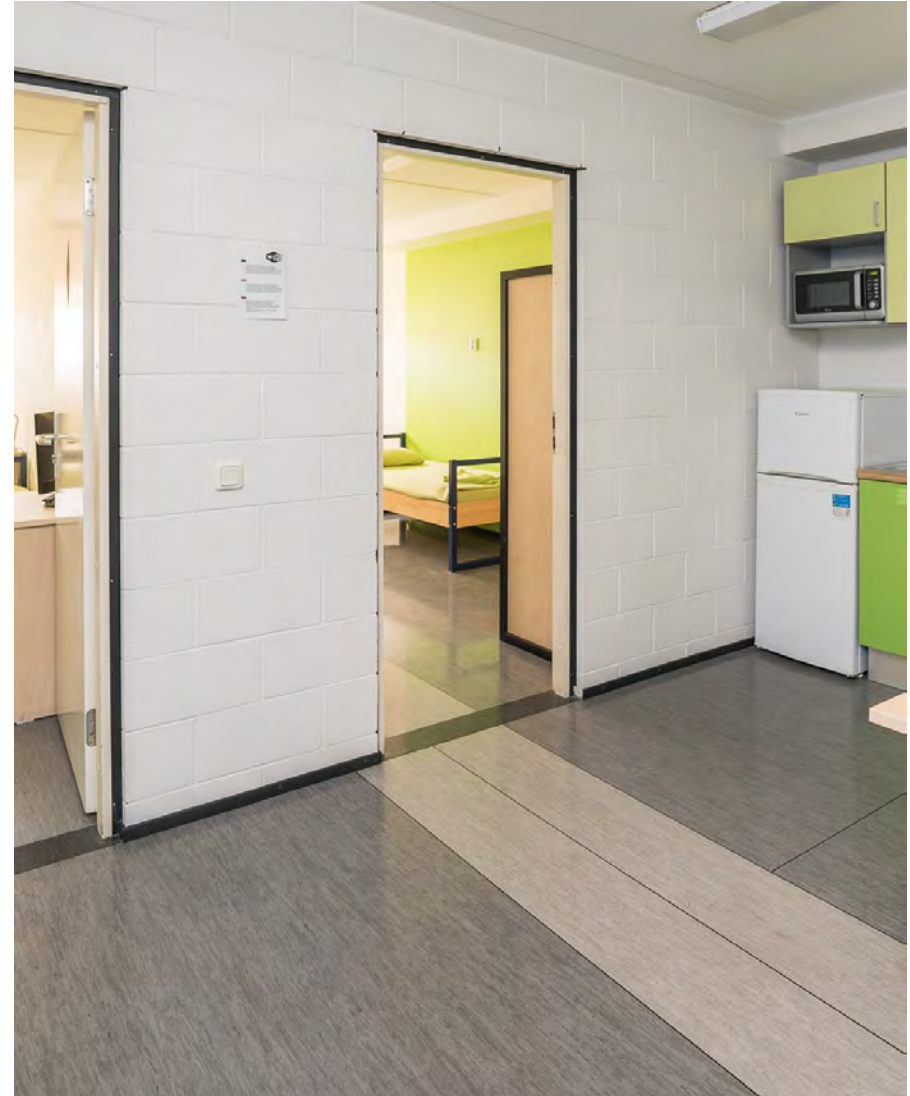
- Accommodation 250-500 euros
